

worth of public infrastructure over the past 25 years in one of Georgia's largest markets through its partnership with Cumberland's private business community.





Key Successes To Date

- Kennedy Interchange (Cumberland Boulevard @ I-75)
- Paces Ferry @ I-285 Interchange
- U.S. 41 Bridge reconstruction (pictured left) and widening
- Cumberland Boulevard: 5-mile loop road connecting the market
- Streetscapes and Trails: Including trails to national park land
- Commuter services: Saved people \$16 million since 1996 and reduced 8,800 tons of harmful pollutants
- ROW Beautification: Around interchanges, local roads and more
