Due to weather impact, the contractor won't install any lane closures until the end of the week.





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Baldwin County... **River bridge rehab lane closures postponed**

MILLEDGEVILLE- Rainy weather has pushed back a planned traffic shift at the Bobby Parham Bridge over the Oconee River. The bridge rehab project should resume by the end of the week.

Weather permitting, Georgia DOT contractors will close both State Route (SR) 22 eastbound lanes heading away from downtown Milledgeville. The normal westbound lanes will carry both travel directions, while Massana Construction Inc. removes and replaces two edge beams and hydro blasts three bridge spans.

Once this work is complete, bridge traffic will flip-flop to all westbound lanes closed with vehicles using the eastbound lanes to navigate the area.

The contractor is allowed 21 consecutive days to perform this work.

This \$2.1 million bridge rehab project also includes one other SR 22 bridge in Baldwin County and the SR 150 bridge over Interstate 20 in McDuffie County. The bridge rehabs feature substructure strengthening, deck rehab, painting, joint replacement and co-polymer deck overlay.
