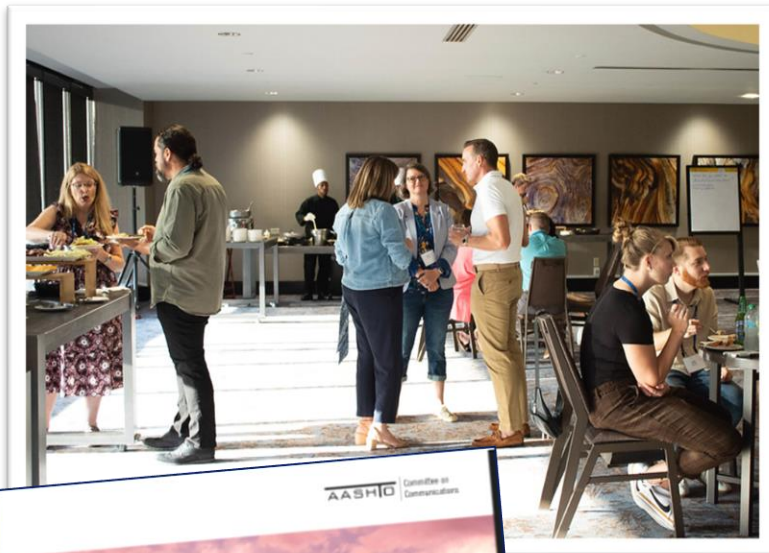

### Georgia DOT Announces Lane Closure Suspensions and Travel Forecast for Thanksgiving Holiday

Atlanta – The Georgia Department of Transportation (Georgia DOT) is helping travelers get to their Thanksgiving destinations with fewer delays. To improve traffic flow during the holiday, Georgia DOT will suspend lane closures on interstates, major state routes, and roads near popular shopping areas from **5 a.m. on Wednesday, Nov. 27, through 10 p.m. on Sunday, Dec. 1.**

This suspension of construction-related lane closures aims to reduce congestion and create a smoother travel experience for everyone. Georgia DOT will implement similar restrictions for the Christmas and New Year holidays.

#### Important Reminders for Travelers:

- While lane closures are suspended, construction crews may still be active near highways, and some long-term lane closures could remain in place for safety reasons.
- Emergency or incident-related lane closures may still occur at any time, as needed.
- Stay alert, follow road signs, and exercise extra caution, particularly during peak travel times.
