

Road Dedication "Conflict Status" Letter Request Form

2023/2024 Legislative Session

This form <u>initiates</u> the dedication process to confirm if there is/are any existing dedication(s) on the requested roadway segment or bridge enacted previously. GDOT will provide this "conflict status" letter under the Commissioner's signature to the requesting legislator, the House and Senate Transportation Committees, and legislative counsel. If the legislator receives a "conflict" letter, the requesting legislator must confer with the legislator's Transportation Committee Chair before legislative counsel will draft the resolution. All dedications are subject to the rules and approval of the House and Senate Transportation Committees.

At the Committees' request, GDOT will confirm **if the requested dedication is contained within the requesting legislator's district**. Please check with the Committee before submitting requests outside of one's district. Per OCGA §32-4-3, dedications are limited to the state route system. Therefore, **local (county and city) roads and bridges are not eligible** for dedication.
