Why is this important to me?

- 1. All transportation partners from the public and private sector have **FREE** access to statewide speed, travel time, reliability, origin-destination, and freight data. Projects no longer need to budget for these expenses.
- 2. All transportation partners from the public and private sector have **FREE** access to trainings, national user groups, and support.
- 3. All projects, regardless of scope, size, or budget, have uniform data analysis capabilities.

What do I need to do in order to take advantage of these offerings?

All public and private sector partner agencies need to sign a Data Use Agreement (DUA). The flow chart below will help you navigate the process.
