WHEREAS, the original Programmatic Agreement Among the Federal Highway Administration, the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Savannah District, the Georgia Historic Preservation Officer, the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation, the Alabama Coushatta Tribe of Texas, the Catawba Indian Nation, and the Muscogee Nation, and the Georgia Department of Transportation Regarding the Section 106 Process for the Transportation Program in Georgia (the original Agreement) was executed on December 13, 2019 and is set to expire on December 13, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the Signatories are in the process of renewing the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Signatories agree to amend the original Agreement for the Transportation Program in Georgia to extend the duration to December 13, 2025 or until the execution of the new PA, whichever comes first; and
