

## Section 636—Highway Signs

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### 636.1 General Description

Low/soft shoulder signs will be utilized on off-system projects (projects not on the State Route System) in the manner they are currently utilized on state system works. Off-system work is performed either as let or non-let (county contract) projects.

#### 636.1.01 Definitions

Off-system Projects: Projects not on the State Route System.

Let Project: Projects constructed by Contractors under Contract to the Department.

Non-let Projects: Projects done under a County Contract.

##### A. Using Low/Soft Shoulder Signs on Off-System Projects

Signs that read, “Low/soft shoulder” are used the same way on off-system Projects as on State-system Work

##### 1. Let Projects.

For Contracts that include shoulder Work, the Contractor must provide, install, maintain, and remove “Low/soft shoulder” signs in accordance with Georgia Standard 9102.

For Contracts with no shoulder work, the Contractor must install and maintain “Low/soft shoulder” signs in accordance with Georgia Standard 9102 except that the signs are provided by the Local Government. The signs protect the travelling public on projects with low or soft shoulders.

##### 2. Non-let Projects.

The local government must place “Low/soft shoulder” signs as required by Georgia Standard 9102. If the counties cannot supply the signs, the Department will supply the required number of signs but no posts. The Area Engineer must keep a detailed record and inventory of the signs given to the counties.
