SUBJECT: Guidelines to Request a Change to a Field Plan Review (FPR) Score

FPR scoring criteria is defined in GDOT Policy 2440-2. Scores of Excellent, Good, and Adequate are considered acceptable and will not be eligible for change. <u>This process</u> only applies to scores of Marginal and Poor.

Requestor (Engineer of Record/Designer, Project Manager)

• Provides clear and obvious errors in scoring to GDOT Project Manger

GDOT Project Manager

- Reaches out to Assistant State Project Review Engineer Design Review in the Office of Engineering Services with request to change score
- Provides clear and obvious errors in scoring approach

Assistant State Project Review Engineer - Design Review

- Reviews requested change(s) with Design Review Manager and Design Reviewer
- If the Design Reviewer and Design Review Manager agree with errors, we will make the change and let the GDOT Project Manager know
- If the Design Reviewer and Design Review Manager do not agree with errors, we will not make the change and let the GDOT Project Manager know
- If we need to discuss, Assistant State Project Review Engineer Design Review will set up a meeting with GDOT Project Manager and Requestor

Design Reviewer

- If no change is made, then there is nothing to do
- If a change is made, then the Design Reviewer will:
 - Revise the scoring summary by striking through the original score, change the text red, and add the new score
 - Add a note stating the score was changed on this date by Engineering Services, but they do not have to provide the reason
 - Distribute report with accepted responses and changed score to PM, as normal
 - Do not revise the original report just the accepted responses report
 - Updates Engineering Services database with the new score and adds a comment saying Engineering Services revised score on this date

Time to Request

• A request to change an FPR score must be submitted within two weeks (10 Business Days) from the distribution of the final FPR report
