Legal and Regulatory

- 1. Nothing contained herein shall be construed to abrogate or affect any lawful ordinance, regulation, or resolution, which is more restrictive. (O.C.G.A. §32-6-97) This is not a building permit. It is the responsibility of the Applicant to comply with any local ordinance, regulation or other requirement prior to erecting the structure.
- 2. All signatures, on all portions of the original application shall be original signatures and in ink. Stamped signatures are not acceptable.
- 3. Only State Route Numbers may be used on this form, where applicable.
- 4. Submit an original and one (1) copy of the Application. Include all attachments with the original application and the copy of the application.
- 5. Applications for permits shall be made to the General Office of the Department of Transportation in Atlanta. Each application shall be accompanied by an application fee (posted on GDOT website) made payable to the <u>Georgia Department of Transportation</u>. Permits shall be renewed annually by April 1st of each year, following the year of issuance.
- 6. Only one (1) permit will be issued per location.
- 7. Signs shall be built as permitted based on the linear dimensions indicated on this permit. Cut-outs or embellishments are not allowed unless they are specifically provided for in this permit and can be accomplished within the dimensional requirement previously stated. A detailed plan for such construction must be submitted along with this application.
- 8. Signs shall also be located in the exact location for which they are permitted. If there are any discrepancies, it shall be the responsibility of the sign owner to correct the location within thirty (30) days of notice by GDOT at his/her own expense. Failure to comply with the location of the permit may result in the revocation of the same.
- 9. The permit identification tag shall be attached to the first sign support and must be clearly visible from the main traveled roadway. It shall remain clear of vegetation, paint or any other obstruction that would obscure its view.
- 10. All signs or proposed locations for a sign under application shall be clearly staked or flagged before being inspected by GDOT.
- 11. All Outdoor Advertising signs, displays, or devices shall be removed by the Permittee within thirty (30) days after the date of expiration or revocation of the permit for same.
- 12. A sign shall be erected and maintained within twelve (12) months after the date of issuance of the permit. If the sign is not completely erected within twelve (12) months, the permit shall expire/shall be deemed expired. [O.C.G.A. §32-6-74(a)].
- 13. The Permittee shall provide notice of completion to GDOT within ten (10) days of completion of construction of a permitted sign. The notice shall include an electronic photograph of the sign as viewed from the main travelled way of the roadway from which the sign is permitted, and an electronic photograph showing the permit identification tag and where it is affixed to the structure.
- 14. Permittee shall not use the Department's right of way while maintaining the sign.
- 15. It shall be cause for GDOT to revoke a sign permit or refuse to issue a sign permit if any of GDOT's property on the rights of way, including but not limited to trees, vegetation, or fences, is destroyed, damaged, converted, or altered by or on behalf of a person, firm, or corporation who owns, erects, maintains, leases, or uses any permitted outdoor advertising sign or structure.

Application Instructions

Applications must be typed or filled out in blue ink. Only completed applications will be reviewed. Incomplete applications will be returned to the Applicant. A permit is valid only for the location specified on the application form.

Applicant / Property Owner Information

- 1. **Name of Applicant or Company**: Person, corporate entity, or Trust in whose name the permit will be listed. This will be the name used by GDOT for all billing notices, violation notices, and any correspondence from GDOT to you. The person or corporate entity name and F.E.I.# / Social Security # you provide on the application should match the name and F.E.I.# / Social Security # on the copy of the W-9 Form you provide.
- 2. **Name of Landowner:** Person, corporate entity, or Trust in whose name the Landowner will be listed. This will be the name used by GDOT for all correspondence to the Landowner.

Property Information

- 3. **Parcel Number**: The parcel identification number (Property Tax ID#) of the land on which the sign is or will be located. This information may be obtained from the county tax assessor's office.
- 4. **Parcel Size and Dimensions**: Provide the dimensions in feet and the parcel size in acres. A detailed property survey may be provided.

Sign Location Information

- 5. **County and Road Information**: Indicate the county in which the sign will be located. Indicate the state route number of the roadway on which you wish to permit the sign. Some roads have two state route number designations. GDOT uses the lower route number.
- 6. **Milepost Information**: Provide the distance in feet to the lower number milepost (not necessarily the closest milepost).
- 7. **Latitude / Longitude**: Provide the latitude/longitude coordinates of your proposed sign location in decimal degrees. If you use *Google Earth* and it shows coordinates in degrees, minutes, seconds, you can change it to read in decimal degrees by clicking on "Tools" and choosing "Options". In the "Options" box you will see a "show lat/long" section that allows you to select "decimal degrees".
- 8. **Resident Consent Form**: If your sign is in an un-zoned area and within 300 feet of any residence, complete and attach the Resident Consent Form. This form can be found on the GDOT Outdoor Advertising webpage.

Sign Description Information

- 9. **Face Length, Width, and Area:** These measurements are taken to the nearest whole foot. The Face Area is the total square feet (length times the height). The Face Area cannot exceed 1,200 square feet.
- 10. **Types of Construction:** Select the configuration that best describes your sign.

Applicant / Landowner Affidavit

- 11. This portion of the application must be completed and notarized.
- 12. In lieu of the Landowner's acknowledgement, attach a lease signed by the Landowner (identifying sign location by state route, county, side of roadway, and distance to milepost). A lease must include a right of entry in favor of and acceptable to GDOT for the purpose of inspecting said sign site or to remove any illegal sign or take any other lawful action regarding the sign.

Location Sketch

13. **Location Sketch:** The location sketch can be drawn in the space provided in the application or attached to the application. The location sketch must show the roadway the sign will be adjacent to, the distance and direction from the nearest intersection(s), commercial and industrial activities in the area, other signs in the area, residences within 300 feet of the proposed sign, and any other identifiable characteristics or landmarks which will assist GDOT in properly identifying the sign location.

Required Attachments: The following attachments (if applicable) are required for a complete application.

- a. A Copy of your W-9 Form.
- b. A detailed Shop Drawing of the sign indicating the plan, elevation, and side views of the sign.
- c. If the location sketch is not drawn in the space provided in the application, provide it as an attachment. The location sketch must show the roadway the sign will be adjacent to, the distance and direction from the nearest intersection(s), commercial and industrial activities in the area, other signs in the area, residences within 300 feet of the proposed sign, and any other identifiable characteristics or landmarks which will assist GDOT in properly identifying the sign location.
- d. For corporate entities or Trusts who are the Applicant and/or Landowner: A signed statement from a corporate officer or executor, on company letterhead, authorizing the Agent(s) to sign this application on their behalf.
- e. If the parcel is in an un-zoned area and within 300 feet of any residences, complete and attach a signed Resident Consent Order Form.
- f. A photograph of the proposed sign site showing the location markings for each pole (if multiple).
- g. If the parcel is listed as Planned Development (PD) or Planned Unit Development (PUD), attach a copy of the plan approved by the local government for review. The primary use of the area or district must be consistent with its zoning designation. A PUD/PD plan which has not been approved by the local government shall not be considered zoned.
- h. If the parcel is listed as Mixed Use, attach a copy of the Mixed Use comprehensive zoning plan. GDOT may consider this type of zoning acceptable for outdoor advertising purposes only if the property in the vicinity of the location under consideration is primarily commercial or industrial.
- i. If the parcel currently has no commercial or industrial development, GDOT must determine if the "Primary Use" of the property is consistent with its commercial or industrial zoning. Attaching documentation that assists in the evaluation will expedite a GDOT review. Recommended attachments are: (1) The assessment of real estate taxes at commercial/industrial rates; (2) Development and construction plans, certified by a licensed professional engineer, for commercial or industrial development scheduled to begin within two years; (3) The zoning of the surrounding area and the actual land uses nearby; and (4) Documents indicating the presence of utilities such as water, electricity, and sewage.
- j. Comprehensive zoning plans must be approved by the GDOT Board for outdoor advertising purposes only. Plans that have not been reviewed and approved or property that has been rezoned since the approval must be reviewed by the Board for compliance with the Georgia Outdoor Advertising Act and the Highway Beautification Act. If your property has been rezoned in the last two (2) to five (5) years, more than likely a review will be required. If so, the following will need to be submitted for the Board review: (1) An approved zoning map with legends and proposed location marked; (2) Current zoning ordinance; (3) Application for rezoning; (4) Approved minutes of the meeting approving the zoning change.
- k. The correct permit fee. (fee amounts are available on the Outdoor Advertising webpage)

Sign Installation Notification

After the Application is granted, the Permittee shall provide notice of completion to GDOT within ten (10) days of completion of construction of a permitted sign. The notice shall include an electronic photograph of the sign as viewed from the main travelled way of the roadway from which the sign is permitted, and an electronic photograph showing the permit identification tag and where it is affixed to the structure.
