I-285/I-20 West Interchange

Fact Sheet

What is the Project?

The I-285/I-20 West Interchange project proposes improvements to the I-285/I-20 West Interchange and the addition of lanes along I-20 in Fulton, Cobb, and Douglas* counties.

Improvements include:

- Removal of left-hand ramp entrance and exits. improvements to horizontal and vertical alignments, and construction of two-lane ramps within the interchange
- Construction of a westbound collector-distributor (CD)** system, or connecting lanes, from the I-285/I-20 West Interchange to Fulton Industrial Boulevard
- Construction of additional lanes along I-20 eastbound from Factory Shoals Road east to Hamilton E. Holmes Drive and along I-285 from MLK Jr. Drive north to Donald Lee Hollowell Parkway to accommodate interchange improvements
- Modification or replacement of bridges within the interchange and along I-20 and I-285

5 Things You Need to Know

- 1. The project will improve traffic flow, reduce congestion. and enhance operations at this system-to-system interchange.
- 2. The American Transportation Research Institute ranks this interchange as the 6th-worst truck bottleneck in the country (2024). The proposed improvements will improve safety for motorists and freight.
- 3. The proposed project's Environmental Assessment document includes studies of the social, natural, cultural, and physical environments within the project limits.
- 4. Project will provide more reliable trips and decrease motorist travel times.
- 5. One of the large-scale Major Mobility Investment Program projects to improve transportation in Georgia's metro areas.

What's the Project Status?

On August 15, 2024, the State Transportation Board of Georgia approved the selection of Legacy Infrastructure Contractors, LLC, to Design-Build-Finance the I-285/I-20 West Interchange project. Legacy Infrastructure Contractors has been selected to complete the next phase of work for the interchange project, including final design and construction. Construction is anticipated to start in late 2025. This schedule is subject to change.
